



The fire hose doesn't belong at a baseball game. It belongs on a fire truck. Jason volunteers to bring it to the firefighters.



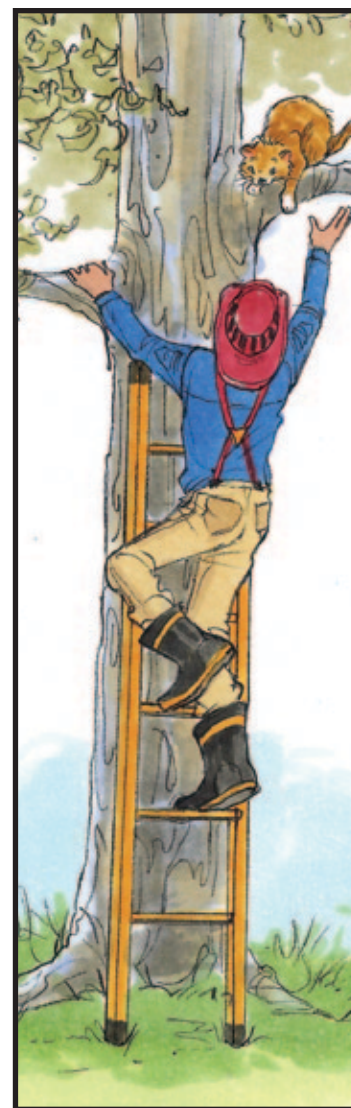
On the way to the fire station, Jason and Bobo stop for lunch. Jason wants two hot dogs and Bobo wants one. How many total hot dogs do they need to buy?

Now it's on to the fire station!

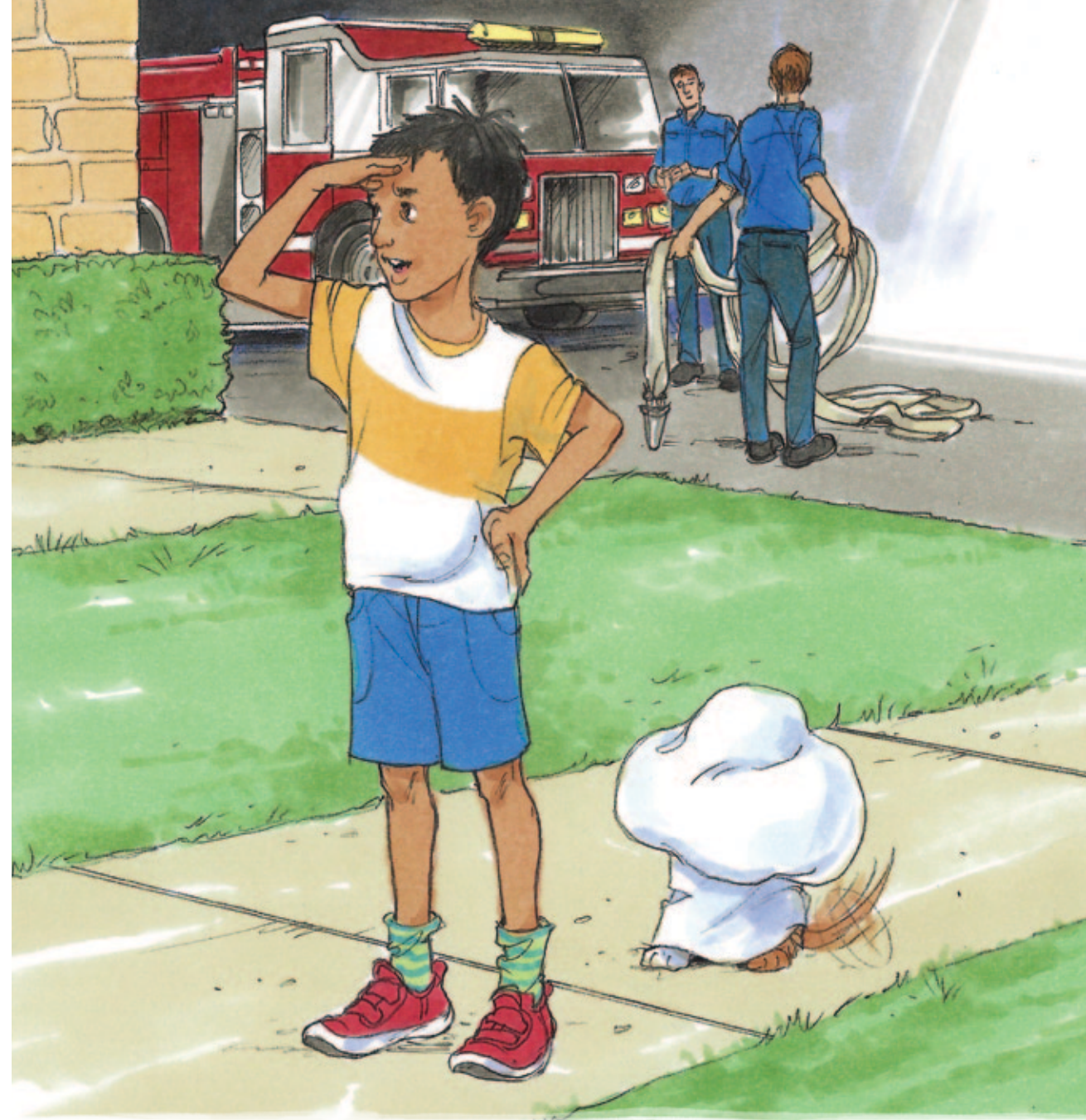
