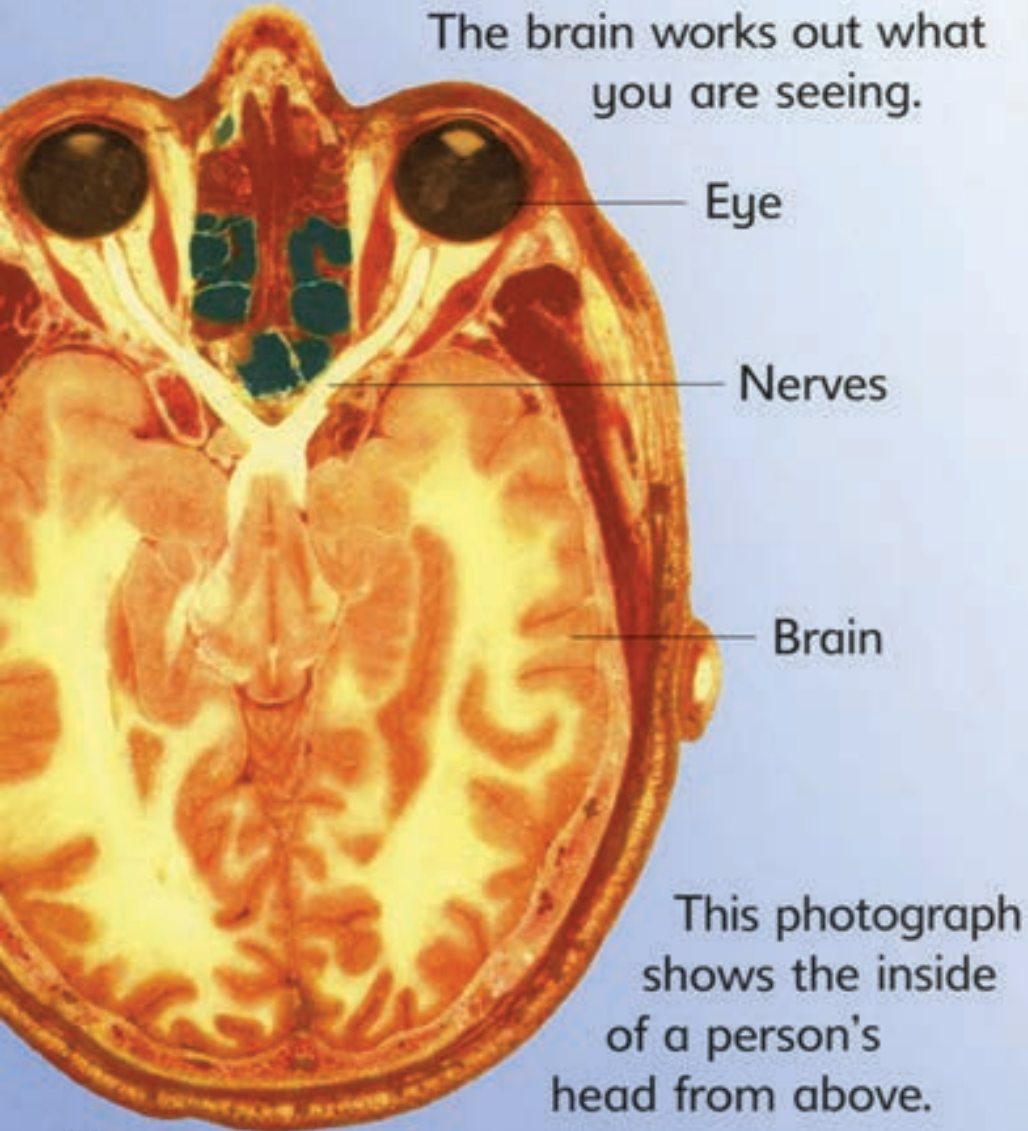


Eyes and seeing

Eyes collect pictures of things around you then nerves send the pictures to the brain.

The brain works out what you are seeing.

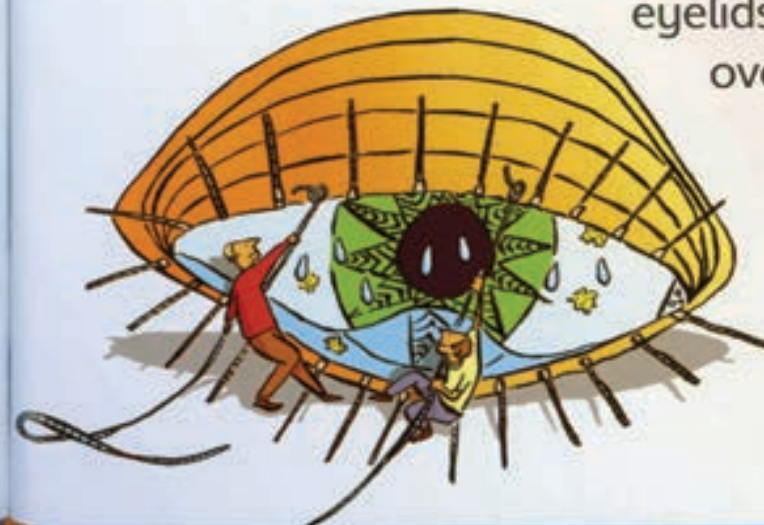


Light goes in each eye through an opening called the pupil.

Pupil

A thin layer of water keeps eyes clean so that you can see clearly.

When you blink, your eyelids wipe water over each eye.



Any specks of dirt are washed out.
