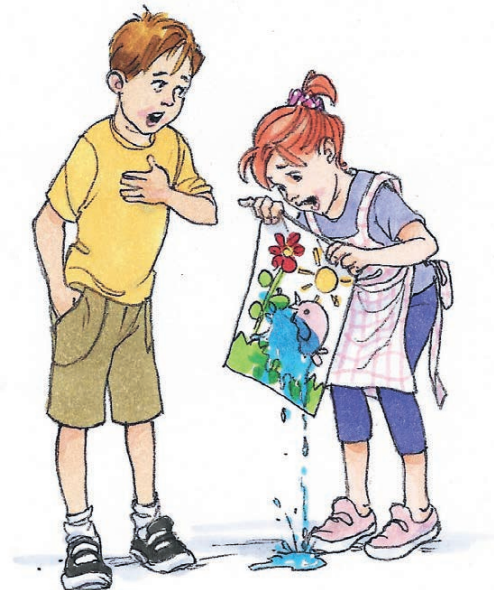
Spilled Paint

Or RUN?!



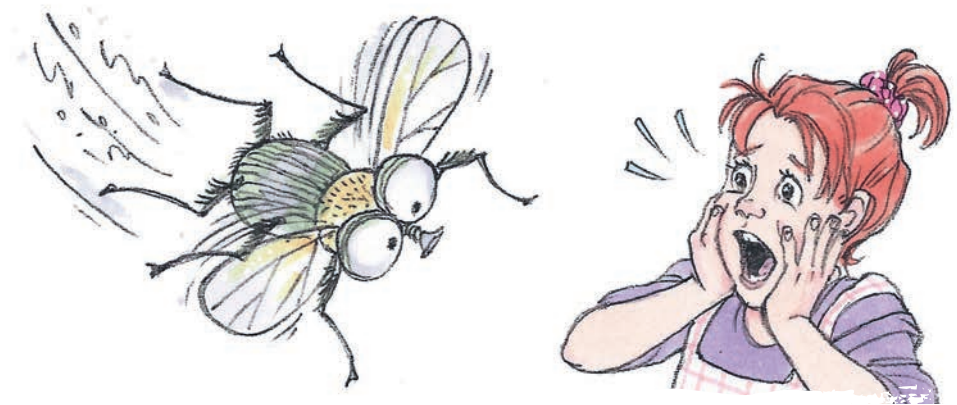
Which one would you choose?
