




WET DAY IN SPAIN








Sim and Matt are waiting for a train to Spain. They plan to camp in the sun.




It is a wet day in Spain! Sim and Matt camp in the rain. The mud is as thick as clay!

for the camp shop.




Matt gets a tray of eggs. He has to wait to pay. He drums his nails on a tin can.



The man in the shop sways and claps his hands to the song.


"Play it again!" he says to Matt.




The man lets Sim and Matt play in the shop. "The best way to spend a wet day!" says Matt.

JUMPING JACK GAME




This is a game for two players. Each player has three counters, each set a different color. Players choose to be Red or Blue and place one counter on each of their colors.
